Frog Heart Physiology - Austin Community College District

The heart of the frog has three chambers, one ventricle and two atria Blood leaves the heart from the ventricle through a single truncus arteriosus which is short and soon branches into two aortic arches which loop left and right and dorsal to the heart to rejoin as a single aorta in the mid dorsal
